How will my child's learning needs be assessed and their progress monitored?

The School has a rigorous programme for assessing all children's learning. Assessment of pupils with SEND include:-

- Teacher observation
- Observational checklists
- End of key stage attainments
- Assessment against year group standards (at the appropriate level for your child)
- Standardised tests
- Information and advice from other agencies
- Forms of assessment which include

recording responses in different environments identifying strengths and weaknesses identifying learning rates and learning styles

Termly reviews of individual support plans and progress towards outcomes

The SENCO/class teacher will be happy to discuss any additional assessments used, the results achieved and the implications for future learning. However, it is felt that something more specialised is required then the relevant service could be contacted to discuss this.

The School sets aspirational targets for all children including those with special educational needs. Individual targets are shared with children so that they are aware of what they need to learn next.
