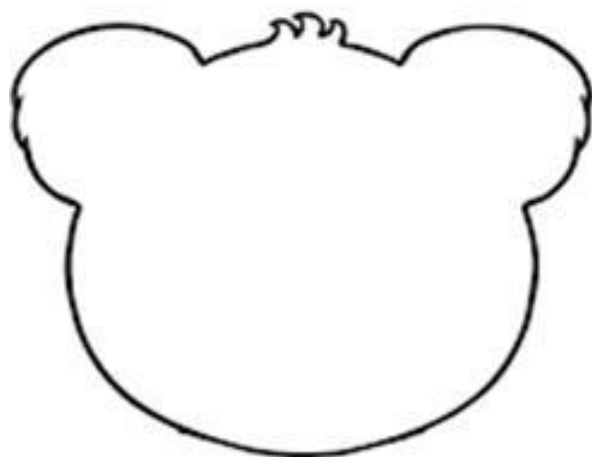
FLU VACCINATION
