# **Kexborough Primary School**

At Kexborough Primary School we believe PE & Sport plays an important role in every pupil's education, with the potential to change young people's lives for the better.

Kexborough Primary School acknowledges the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of its children. We also recognise that a broad, balanced, high quality curriculum and extra-curricular activities have a positive impact on concentration, attitude and achievement. The Sport Premium funding is allowing us to develop a sustainable improvement in teacher confidence. Regular staff training opportunities are provided for teachers and teaching assistants (TAs) to keep them abreast of new initiatives.

## **Sport Premium Grant**

Funding for schools will be calculated by the number of primary aged pupils (between the ages of 5 and 11) as at the annual census in January 2019. All schools with 17 or more primary aged pupils will receive a lump sum of £16,000 plus a premium of £10 per pupil. Smaller schools will receive £500 per pupil.

## What does the Sport Premium mean for my School?

'Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this' (DfE June 2013).

At Kexborough Primary School we have split up the funding by the three key areas for consideration; Physical Education, Healthy Active Lifestyles and Competitive Sport. We have decided to spend the Sport Premium Grant on the following:
